**6.1** Applications must be filed with the Examination Secretariat at the address given above. Candidates are advised to submit their application by registered letter with advice of delivery. The application must reach the Examination Secretariat **no later than 12 September 2011**.

Where a document transmitted by facsimile is illegible or incomplete, the facsimile shall be deemed not to have been received.

Candidates may also hand in their application at one of the EPO post rooms (Munich, The Hague or Berlin) and bring their own copy to be stamped to confirm receipt.
